



<Active Cooperation Request for SKIS Saturday School Safe Management in Response to COVID-19>

Dear Parents, Thank you for your big support for SKIS Saturday school as always. Recently, the number of infected people in the COVID-19 region has soared (Total 457 as of 9 September 2021, MOH statistics), which requires strict management. Therefore, we would like to inform you of the main points of the COVID-19 response safe management plan reflecting the Singapore government (MOH, MOE, CPE, etc.) guidelines as below, please take note to the following strongly.

《 Safe Management Plan in response to COVID-19 》

- ◆ **(Target) Students** or their household members living with them who have been designated Quarantine Order (QO), Stay-Home Note (SHN), and Health Risk Warning (HRW) by the Singapore government.
- ◆ **(Request)** ① When the above fact has been occurred to students or students' family members, **please inform those fact to the class teacher** or admin office immediately, ② And, **do not send students to Saturday School Class**, ③ When the quarantine period ends, please submit the PCR Test confirmation result to the office and we will conduct ART test to the students before student's returning to the classroom.
- ※ Students living with Health Risk Alert (HRA) designation or subject to HRA can come to school only if they have no health issues, but even in this case, please inform students' HRA fact to your class teacher or admin office.
- ◆ **(Note)** Students with respiratory symptoms such as a high fever of 37.5 degrees or higher, cough, sneezing, and runny nose will be sent home, so if students have similar symptoms of those at home, do not let them go to school and inform us.

As all parents know, students at Saturday School stay in different schools on weekdays. Considering the characteristics of Saturday School, which operates on Saturdays, please kindly understand that we need to manage it more thoroughly and actively cooperate for the health and safety of our students.

We will continue to follow all of the COVID-19 safe management measures as well as do our best to keep our students healthy on safe class environment. Thank you for your continued understanding & cooperation.
