Topic: Drug abuse among teenagers is an ongoing crisis that the world is facing. According to a report by NCDAS, 50% of teenagers have misused drug at least once. Around 43.7% of youths have tried marijuana in their lifetime. Also, 788,000 teenagers aged 12-17 years old met the criteria for Illicit Drug Use Disorder.

Your task: Write a practice essay discussing a few solutions you can think of to address this problem.

Your essay should be in the following format:

1. Introduction (5 sentences min) - Introduction and description of problem
Thesis Statement (1-2 sentences) - A thesis statement should be the last sentence of the Introduction paragraph.

2. Body paragraphs (3 paragraphs):

Solution 1- State the 1st solution by explaining and providing support.

Solution 2- State the 2nd solution by explaining and providing support.

Solution 3- State the 3rd solution by explaining and providing support.

3. Conclusion (5 sentences min) - Summary of solutions and closing statement.

Each paragraph should be well developed with a point, elaboration, examples and a transition or concluding statement.

Note: A well-developed essay is more important than a long essay.

Please submit the essay in the following format:

1. Font- Times New Roman 12 Font
2. Indent the first sentence of each paragraph and leave a space between the paragraphs.
3. Write the title of the topic followed by your name and date on the right hand side of the paper.
